

Neighbourhood Area Designation – Hernhill Parish Council

Hernhill Parish Council has made an application to Swale Borough Council to designate a neighbourhood area. This is an area within which a neighbourhood plan can be prepared. Neighbourhood plans give communities power to develop a shared vision for their neighbourhood and shape the development and growth of their local area.
